<p>Although it is now possible to register on said platform without nonfree JS, the website's ToS are still somewhat dangerous.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• They state the ToS may be altered at any time and it takes effect immediately without the need for the user to be notified or even read them,</li><li>• they state that disputes will be resolved through arbitration instead of a court case and</li><li>• they forbid the user from taking part in class action lawsuits against site operator.</li></ul> <p>In addition, it allows for the above unfair provisions to be nullified if the user sends an explicit written request to the Stack Exchange headquarters within 30 days from registering.</p> <p>I guess it would be good if the registration script presented a prominent notice about all this</p>
